In Her Shoes:

Navigating Medical School as a Female Student

It's 2024—a decade marked by breaking taboos, advancing equality, healing from a global pandemic, and enduring economic upheavals, all while keeping the flame of learning alive. For me, this year holds



special significance as it marks the culmination of my journey with the addition of “Dr.” before my name. My experience in the medical field has been enlightening, and I’m excited to share my perspective as a female doctor.

I vividly remember June 2019, when, with tears of joy in my eyes, I told my parents that I had passed the medical entrance exam and was on my way to becoming a doctor. The day is still etched in my memory—seeing my father’s tears of pride, my mother’s constant gratitude, my brother’s pride, and my family celebrating the first doctor in our lineage. That day, I made a vow to become the best version of myself—a doctor who is unbiased and meets the needs of our society.

However, now, five years later, I find myself questioning, “Does society truly need me?” The harsh realities of medical practice, including the alarming rates of medical student suicides, attacks on doctors, and even assaults on female doctors, weigh heavily on my heart. Each news headline that surfaces only deepens my family’s concern for my safety.

Despite having supportive friends, colleagues, and staff who ensure my safety, it raises a troubling question: Why should women need such protection in the first place? Why is it that men don’t face these same safety concerns? These issues impact female healthcare workers and aspiring doctors, affecting their sense of security and career aspirations.

In August 2019, our professor taught us the principle of "Do No Harm," which was initially understood as a directive for patient care. Today, I find myself questioning this principle in a broader context. A



safe working environment should not be considered a privilege but a fundamental right. Women should not have to fight for basic safety or equality in their workplaces. It is disheartening to hear blame placed on women for not being accompanied by other females, being in certain places at specific times, or even working night shifts.

While these darker aspects are undeniably part of the story, I also want to highlight the positives. Alteration in career pathways after 12th- So many good options available

I am Nishka Mehta, currently pursuing Pharm.D course in my second year. I am a student at K.B.I.P.E.R. College, Gandhinagar. Back in 2019 I had decided I wanted to choose medicine as my career further in life. My father is a doctor so from childhood I had seen him work and I was always inspired to become like him right from the beginning. Being in a doctor's family, everybody would tell me that I would be a doctor and carry on my father's work. So at some point, I did have a goal to be a doctor one day but I think everyone's expectations around me also did influenced the decision of choosing B group in science stream after 10th standard. Although, my parents did warn and made me understand that I should not pursue medicine as a career, but I was adamant somehow and just went for it. So in 2021, I started my 11th in science stream and went to a dummy school and attended private tuition classes for physics, chemistry and biology. As I began my 11th classes and tests, I loved learning new things each and every day. But 8 months into it and it had become a monotonous life which had the same routine over and over. It had become very difficult for me to go through all that, sometimes I also thought of changing the stream, sometimes I broke into tears both in front of my parents and alone. But I just kept doing the same thing repeatedly and tried convincing myself to not to give up on this. I know some of us do feel the same, especially us the students. We just think of our parents, society and everybody around us and I did the same mistake. Even though my parents were very supportive and they suggested to me to just consider my own choices and don't get influenced by anybody's judgments, but I still did it thinking that maybe I will do better in 12th and I will score better marks. Then similarly my 12th standard started, I still continued my tuition classes and also joined the practical classes for all the subjects (PCB). Somehow, my marks were better than in the 11th but still I was very much lacking in all subjects. It's not that I was



bad at studies but I think preparation for the medical entrance exam was just not for me. Everyone in my classes were so competitive that whenever I got below average marks, I felt inferior from all of them and didn't want to talk with anyone because I used to think that they will judge and make me feel lesser than them. At some point of time, I was afraid of exams and talking about my test marks. But 2 months before NEET, I kind of did have an idea that I would not be able to clear it. I also thought that I should have studied for these 2 years and I would not be able to make my parents proud but time does not wait for anyone. There was the day of the competitive exam in May, I was anxious, nervous and had loads of anxiety that day but somehow I did give the exam and came back home with mixed emotions not even knowing that what result I would get. I enjoyed my vacations at home and the result day was after 2 months in July. As speculated, I didn't get the marks needed for getting the admission in medical college in Ahmedabad. I was shocked and very sad after getting the results. By the merit, I was not getting government seat but I did not want to get admission through the management quota anywhere. So I decided that this course is not for me and I should change career line. There were many options after giving the 12th board exam for me which I didn't even think of. For example : I could go into Ayurveda , dental , physiotherapy , nursing, pharmacy , homeopathy, biomedical research , microbiology, bachelor of science and so many more. I applied in dental course, physiotherapy course and we even went to NFSU (National forensic science university) for inquiring about the forensic science and cyber security courses. But due to some circumstances, I could not get admission in the university. I even went for biomedical research and genetics course inquiry but that was also not something I had my mind on. One day, my father told me about Pharm.D course which he got to know about from his friends which was very new and I knew nothing about it. So I searched about it , its future scopes , what can I expect from the course , its subjects and surprisingly I like it and I gave my father the green signal that I am interested in pursuing this integrated 6 years course. This course also has many job scopes in India and foreign,



countries too. We first went to L.M. College of pharmacy but to get admission there I would have to have given the GUJCET exam which I had not given. So then I went to K.B.I.P.E.R which is the first pharmacy college to have started Pharm.D course in Gujarat. We got to know about its details and scopes in the future. Then I filled the admission form and I got admission in august 2023 through the merit lists. I was very happy to have gotten admission in the college and I am very diligently studying here at present. I just want to convey the message to all the students in 11th and 12th that there are number of alternative career paths after 12th standard and nobody should be disheartened if things go the other way and just keep looking for other opportunities and I am sure that you will get the one which is for you. The alteration in career pathway was hard but was totally worth it and I am so thankful for my decision and my family.

Ms. Nishka is daughter of our colleague Dr. Ankur Mehta leading Pathologist in Ahmedabad. She did not give up when she did not get admission in medical instead she discussed with friends and guardians and took a intelligent decision for next career pathway.
